Corkscrew

A hinged corkscrew is a tool used for opening wine bottles by removing their corks. It is composed of a handle, a metal lever, and a screw. To open a bottle of wine using a hinged corkscrew you must:

- Remove the metal foil covering the top of the bottle.
- Unfold the hinged corkscrew and place the tip of the screw on the cork.
- Twist the screw into the cork using a clockwise motion. Stop screwing before going all the way through the cork.
- Take the metal lever and place it on the edge of the bottle.
- Pull up on the handle pushing the lever into the mouth of the bottle thereby lifting the cork out.
- Pour your wine into a glass and drink!
